Good afternoon SJS Community,

In October, Fr. Tom announced that Canton's two Catholic parishes, St. Gerard Majella and St. John the Evangelist, were requesting permission to merge into a single parish. Cardinal Sean has granted this request and the parishes will be officially merged on February 1. The name of Canton's new parish will be St. Oscar Romero Parish. Please see attached for a letter from Fr. Tom. This merger will not affect the name of St. John School.

As Fr. Tom writes in his letter, St. Oscar Romero is a saint of our times. He was an outspoken proponent of the rights of the poor and the marginalized. He was a pacifist who opposed violence on all sides of the political divide. A quote from St. Oscar Romero that Fr. Tom and the parish staff have been using is "Let us not tire of preaching love; it is the force that will overcome the world." This ties so directly and wonderfully into our theme for the past few years - Love Radically. Another St. Oscar Romero quote that epitomizes what we do at St. John School is, "Aspire not to have more but to be more." This is a philosophy that we want our students to embody. While we remain St. John School, we are a proud part of St. Oscar Romero Parish and know that we will live out his message of love and peace. St. Oscar Romero's feast day is March 24 and we will celebrate that day and introduce him to our students.
